#1...YOUR FONDEST MEMORIES FROM WALTER JOHNSON H.S. YEARS:

I went to WJHS my sophomore year and moved away. I would have graduated with this class and I made a number of friends while at WJHS, which is why I had my name added to the list of graduates. Most of the classmates were friends throughout elementary and junior high.

I went to Alta Vista one year[K] then attended Wyngate elementary through 6th. Next I went to North Bethesda Jr. High 7-9.

Among my memories is a snow that started with very fine flakes and soon became a near blizzard so that school was dismissed early. I think there is a picture in the yearbook from that year.

I remember skipping school to attend the John Glenn parade – only to find out later that school was dismissed early for that purpose.

#2...WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN DOING OVER THE LAST 50 YEARS? It has been 50 years - wow. The move, my dad got a new job with World Health Organization and we were to move to Jamaica. That plan was derailed when we discovered that he had Alzheimer's disease. We rented an apartment since our home was rented with a years contract. I attended Bethesda Chevy Chase my junior year, that was a fast year. My parents had relatives in Neosho, Missouri and we moved again this time to Neosho, Missouri. I attended Neosho HS my senior year. After graduation I attended a VoTech at [then] Pittsburg State Teachers College in Pittsburg, Kansas. I enlisted in the Marine Corps just barely ahead of the draft and became a Fire Control Radar Technician and worked on F-4 Phantom.

When I exited USMC I returned to college and earned AAS at Crowder College. A few years later I was asked to teach at Crowder and accepted the position. I taught at Crowder 1978 to 1990 While teaching at Crowder College I earned my BS degree at Missouri southern University Joplin Mo. I left Crowder in 1990 to accept position working for the FFA teaching avionics. This was an upward mobility program. The DOT closed the program [not my fault] two years later.

I accepted a teaching position at North Arkansas College [Northark] and taught electronic technology subjects and a number of other courses. The last eleven years at Northark I mostly taught Cisco Networking Academy courses including CCNA and CCNP curriculum.

I retired in 2010 with my health and happiness intact.

My wife Jan and I celebrated our 45th wedding anniversary October this year. She deserves the greatest credit for putting up with so much for so long. In my heart she has earned the title of Marine.

We have been blessed with three daughters who have blessed us with 7 grandchildren.

YOUR FONDEST MEMORIES FROM WALTER JOHNSON HIGH SCHOOL YEARS:

I would like to go back and re-live my WJHS years again—not because I did so well, but because I did not do so well. In fact, my WJ years remind me of this apocryphal colloquy: Student to Teacher: "You gave me a zero on my test. I don't think I deserved a zero." Teacher: "Neither do I, but that was the lowest grade I could give you." Perhaps my best memories come from my involvement with music, inspired by the musicians who used to hang out at the old smoking area, and brought into focus through trumpet lessons with Dave Teel (WJ's principal trumpet player). This led to my participation in the band at WJ and in college, and some good times at both places. Other memories relate to friendships established at WJ. I have been in contact with many of my WJ friends all these years; and we have served as a mutual support group through life's rites of passage. For me, WJ was a mass of missed opportunities. If I had it to do over, I might do better. Maybe.

WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN DOING OVER THE LAST 50 YEARS?

I spent two years at Muskingum College in Ohio. (Dottie Weymouth was briefly a student there also.) Tuition was \$595/semester! When our German professor gave us a choice of taking an exam or going around town singing German Christmas carols, we opted for singing. Among those we serenaded (on a bitterly cold night) was the family of John Glenn (Muskingum's most famous alum). I was in two dramatic productions, and thus appeared on the same stage on which Agnes Moorehead had performed four decades earlier. After two years in Ohio, I transferred to American University. During my undergraduate years, I worked summers at Garrett Park Esso, with such other former WJ students as Ken Henderson, Jim Clark, Bob Mortland, and Brian Sherline. After graduating from American University, I worked for several years at Sibley Hospital, where I was in charge of storeroom inventory. Thereafter, I was in graduate school, first at American University, then at the University of Maryland, where I also served as a teaching assistant. All of that training in history led to employment at the National Archives. It was at the National Archives that I met my future wife Dale, whom I married several years later—Bob Spaulding (the only clergyman produced by the Class of 1964) helped conduct the ceremony, and WJ grads Gary Rowland and Don Taylor filled in as ushers. Dale and I and our son Jason took two trips to Europe, and Dale and I turned out to watch Jason act in theater productions at Montgomery College and George Mason University. Last spring, we flew to North Hollywood to visit Jason, who is now an aspiring actor. Life has been good.
