Frankly, I don't remember much. While I liked going to WJ, I wasn't sad to leave. I only kept in touch with one classmate, Rich Rable, and even that was sporadic. I do remember several other people, specifically because I spent many years in school with them somewhere between elementary and high school. There were at least two (Tig Green, Glenn Bledsoe), maybe four or five more, with whom I was in school every year, all the way from Alta Vista Elementary to Grosvenor Elementary to North Bethesda Junior High and finally to WJ.

#2...WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN DOING OVER THE LAST 50 YEARS?

After leaving WJ, I went to the University of Louisville, graduating in 1968 (BA in Political Science, member of Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity). From there, I joined the Navy and spent 3+ years on the USS Observation Island (AG-154) in Port Canaveral FL, Portsmouth VA, and Pearl Harbor HI. I can't claim to have done anything exceptional in the military - never went to Viet Nam - just steaming around in the middle of the Atlantic and later the Pacific for weeks at a time and crossing the International Date Line somewhere west of Midway Island six times in a period of about three weeks.

After the Navy I returned to Louisville and started working for the Commonwealth Life Insurance Company (which was eventually merged out of existence by AEGON, a large Dutch financial corporation). I pretty much sat at the same desk for my entire career, but the company kept changing owners and names. By the time I was done, after 33 years, I ended up working for the Transamerica Life Insurance Company, thanks to all the mergers. I retired in 2005 as a senior life and health insurance underwriter in the home office.

I married a local Louisville girl in 1977 and have one daughter, Lauren, who is a TV anchor for the ABC station in Bowling Green KY. We moved to Hilton Head Island after my retirement, where I have a part time job that fills the gaps between sleeping and generally doing nothing (which is OK with me). I've only been back in the Bethesda area two or three times in 45 years, the last almost 20 years ago. However, I have a number of cousins spread throughout Montgomery and Frederick Counties, so maybe I'll come through again someday. Chances are the next move will be to go back to Kentucky in a year or two. That may seem strange to those of you who still live in the Washington DC area, since Louisville is smaller and less exciting by comparison. However, I've always liked Louisville. 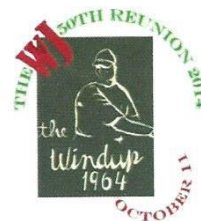

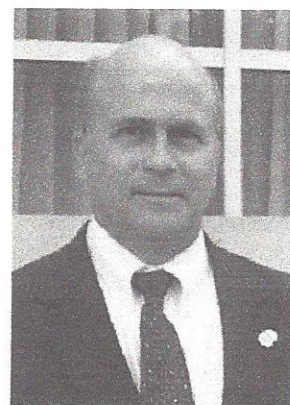
